
THE DRAMATISTS GUILD mourns the loss of lyricist and librettist Tom Jones

A Guild member for over 60 years, Tom is best remembered for writing the book and lyrics to the world's longest running musical "The Fantasticks," which played off-Broadway for 42 years. Other credits include the Broadway musicals "I Do! I Do!" "Celebration," and "110 in the Shade," all written with his "Fantasticks" collaborator, composer Harvey Schmidt. Tom received Tony nominations for his work on "I Do! I Do!" and "110 in the Shade," the latter of which was revived in a 2007 Broadway production starring Audra McDonald.

A 1998 inductee into the American Theatre Hall of Fame, Tom was also the recipient of an Obie Award, an ASCAP Richard Rodgers Award, and a special Tony Award for "The Fantasticks."
